




Out of 5,000 patients that were placed on Dolphin for prevention purposes:



From July 2022 to March 2024 (600 days), 34% of Category 1,2,3 and 4 pressure ulcers (PUs) were hospital acquired (HAPU).




What would the savings be if these treatment patients had been placed on Dolphin Therapy for prevention of skin damage, and 98% of these HAPUs were prevented?




